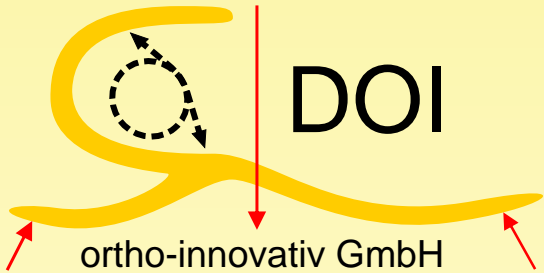
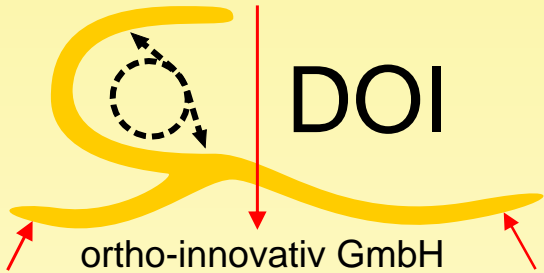
DOI and O-PAEDIX
